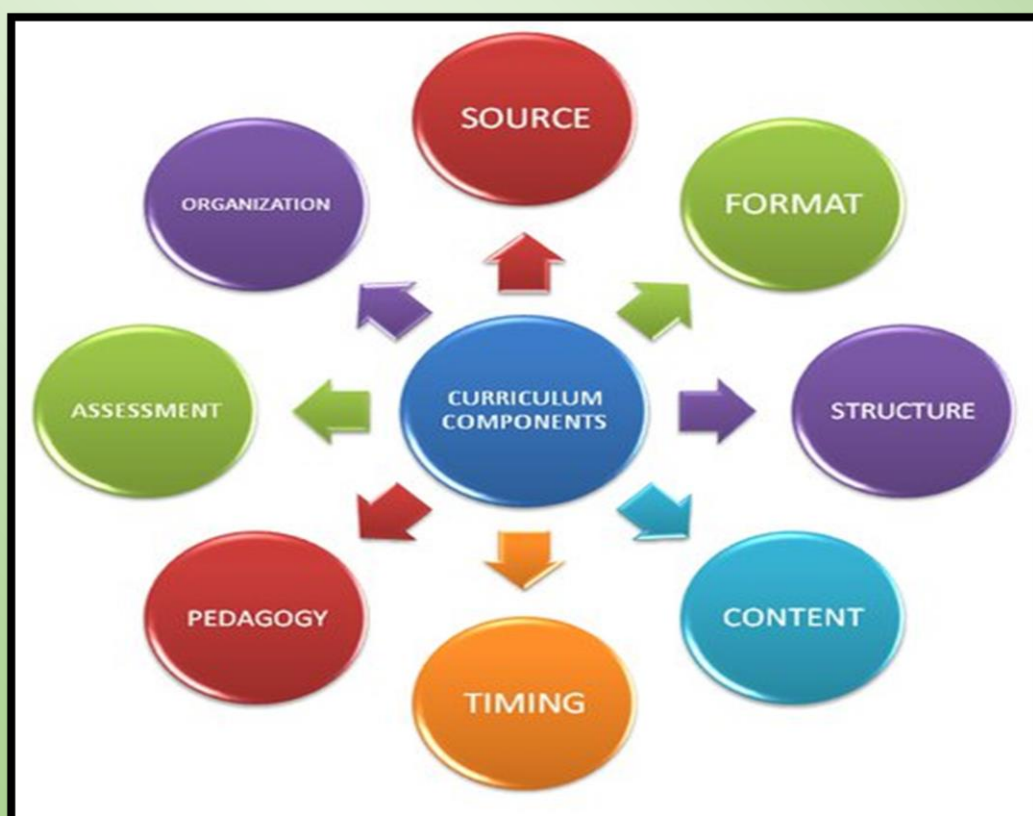

EFFECTIVE CURRICULUM PLANNING AND DELIVERY

Government College Bichhua, Chhindwara is affiliated with Raja Shankar Shah University Chhindwara (previously known as Chhindwara University). For PG courses, it follows the syllabus prescribed by the parent university and for UG Classes the institution adheres to the unified curriculum developed by the Department of MP Higher Education.

The various bodies in the institution execute different strategies to ensure effective curriculum delivery through a well-planned and documented process.

- 1. The Department of Higher Education, Madhya Pradesh provides an annual academic calendar at the beginning of each session delineating the schedule for all significant activities and holidays. The institute**



conducts all literary, cultural, sports and other important activities as per the academic calendar. The university approves and assigns the subject experts as external examiners for practical, projects, viva voce and internship activities.

2. The complete curriculum delivery is according to the academic calendar of the Department of MP Higher Education including Internal Assessment, Youth Festival, and Student Union formation, Sports Activities, Extension Activities, Cultural Activities and Examination. The college regards effective delivery of the curriculum as the most vital curricular aspect.
3. The session commences with '*College Chalo Abhiyan*', Online Admissions followed by Zero Classes, Bridge Classes and Know Your College/Induction Programs for First Year students. From the session 2021-22, NEP (National Education Policy 2020) was implemented in the institute. The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) is implemented for enabling choice of selection for Elective papers to the students.



- 4. The institution (IQAC) drafts the time-table and ensures appropriate teaching-learning practice as per the time-table. The institution operates in two shifts, the morning shift has Commerce & Science faculties while the afternoon shift consists of Arts faculty. The time-table of theory and practical classes is displayed on the notice board as well as on the website of the institution and classes are conducted accordingly.**
- 5. The syllabus of each subject is available on the institution's website. The principal ensures the distribution of syllabi among the faculties of each department at the beginning of the academic session as per their expertise. Each department's head and faculty member plan to complete the entire syllabus in the scheduled time. The faculty members maintain the class-wise attendance register along with their daily diary.**
- 6. The conventional classrooms are incorporated with ICT-enriched classes. Apart from classroom teaching some other alternatives like**



special lectures, projects, internships, educational tours, assignments, etc are also carried out for efficient curriculum delivery. Drama enactment has been in practice in literature classes. Each department submits a detailed report of departmental activities/exercises to IQAC periodically. The achievements of objectives of the syllabus are measured through students' performance in Internal Tests, Group Discussions, Presentations and University Examinations.





- 7. Various expert lectures have been organized by the different departments of the college in respect to the prescribed syllabi, which enables the students to get knowledge from expert teachers from other colleges and also provides opportunities to clear doubts and queries.**
- 8. Along with the degree courses the institution offers Add-on certificate courses to the students on vocational subjects, skill-based subjects and Indian Traditional Knowledge.**
- 9. The college encourages the faculty to participate in Orientation and Refresher courses to update their knowledge. The college encourages the faculty to attend the meetings of BOS. The college takes initiative and encourages staff to attend workshops for effectively implementing CBCS method of imparting curriculum.**
- 10. The institution has a well-organized Library which plays a vital role in providing information services for students, faculties/ staff and the local community as well. The library has a very rich collection of texts and reference books along with subscriptions of various e-journals and**

e-books from reputed publishers. The students may avail the borrowing privileges of three books for 15 days. As per the guidelines of DHE free books and stationery are provided to the students of the SC and ST categories. Departmental libraries are also functioning in each department along with borrowing privileges for Post Graduate students.

- 11. The college collects feedback from the faculty, students, alumni and parents. The collected feedback is analysed using different parameters and the performance of the students, faculty and institution is assessed. Any discrepancies identified are considered for correction and suggestions are taken for improvement.**
