

#### 1.Background of Project

छिंदवाड़ा सतपुड़ा रेंज के दक्षिण पश्चिम क्षेत्र पर स्थित है l छिंदवाड़ा जिले में अधिकांश जनजातीय आबादी है। आदिवासी समुदायों में गोंड, प्रधान, भारीया, कोरकू शामिल हैं। जिले में हिंदी, मराठी, गोंडी, उर्दू, कोरकृ, मुसाई, पारवारी आदि भाषाओं / बोलियों का इस्तेमाल होता है। अधिकांश आदिवासी गाँधी और हिंदी में मराठी के साथ मिलते हैं। छिन्दवाड़ा शहर पोला, भुजलिया, मेघनाथ, अखाड़ी, हरज्योति सांस्कृतिक कार्यों / त्योहारों के लिए प्रसिद्ध हैं। छिंदवाड़ा जिला 1 नवंबर, 1956 को बनाया गया था। यह 'पहाड़ों की सतपुरडा रेंज' के दक्षिण-पश्चिमी क्षेत्र में स्थित है। यह 21.28 से 22.4 9 डिग्री तक फैला हुआ है। उत्तर (रेखांश) और 78.40 से 79.24 डिग्री पूर्व (अक्षांश) और 11,815 वर्ग किलोमीटर क्षेत्र में फैला हुआ है। यह जिला दक्षिण में नागपुर जिले (महाराष्ट्र राज्य में) के मैदानों, उत्तर पर होशंगाबाद और नरसिंहपुर जिले, पश्चिम में बेतुल जिला और पूर्व में सिवनी जिले की सीमाओं से लगा हुआ है। उपरोक्त अध्ययन में "महाविद्यालीन जनजाति छात्राओं में शिक्षा एवं कानून की जागरूकता का एक समाजशास्त्रीय अध्ययन"(छिंदवाड़ा शहर के विशेष सन्दर्भ में) किया गया । छिन्दवाड़ा शहर में 4 महाविद्यालय हैं,जिनमें 3 शासकीय एवं एक अर्द्धशासकीय महाविद्यालय हैं। उक्त अध्ययन में छिंदवाड़ा शहर के 4 महाविद्यालयों में से एक शासकीय (राजमाता सिंधिया शासकीय कन्या स्नातकोत्तर महाविद्यालय छिन्दवाड़ा) एवं एक अर्द्धशासकीय महाविद्यालय(डेनियलसन डिग्री महाविद्यालय छिन्दवाड़ा) का चयन सुविधाजनक देव निदर्शन पद्धति के मध्य्यम से किया गया हैं। उपरोक्त दोनों महाविद्यालयों में से 300 जनजाति छात्राओं का चयन स्तरीकृत देव निदर्शन(उद्देश्पूर्ण देव निदर्शन पद्धति) के माध्यम से किया गया हैं। उपरोक्त अध्ययन में जनजाति छात्राओं में शिक्षा एवं कानून की जागरूकता का अध्ययन किया गया हैं। जनजाति छात्राएं शिक्षा एवं कानून के प्रति जागरूक हैं।

#### प्रस्तावना :(Introduction)

पंचायती राज में महिला सशक्तिकरण की मात्रा क्षेत्र एवं परिस्थिति के अनुसार भिन्न रही है। जिन पंचायतीराज संस्थाओं में महिला प्रतिनिधि स्वयं मामलों के देखकर निर्णय प्रक्रिया पूरी सिक्रयता से संपन्न करवाती है तो माना जा सकता है कि उन महिलाओं का पूर्ण सशक्तिकरण हुआ है। इसके विपरीत अगर महिला प्रतिनिधि अपने घर से स्वतंत्र रूप से बाहर नहीं आती घूँघट नहीं हटा पाती और अपने पति या संबंधी के कहने पर ही दस्तावेजों पर हस्ताक्षर करती है। तो कहा जा सकता है कि उन महिला प्रतिनिधियों का सशक्तिकरण नहीं हुआ है। पंचायतीराज ने ग्रामीण क्षेत्र एवं वंचित (दिलत) वर्ग की महिलाओं को परिवार,जाति एवं समाज में उच्च स्थिति प्रदान करने में महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका अदा की है क्योंकि इनमें बी.पी.एल. एवं कमजोर तबके की महिलाएँ भी निर्वाचित हो रही हैं इसलिए उनका सामाजिक, आर्थिक, सांस्कृतिक एवं राजनीतिक सशक्तिकरण हो रहा है।

भारत जैसे देश की अधिकांश जनता अभी भी ग्रामों में निवास करती है। गांवों में कृषि ही अभी तक आजीविका का मुख्य साधन रहा है। अगर इन क्षेत्रों की महिलाओं को स्व—उद्यमी बनाकर खड़ा किया जा सकें, तो उनके सशक्तिकरण के साथ—साथ कृषि संकट से भी कुछ राहत मिल सकेंगी। आय के एक से अधिक स्त्रोत होने से ग्रामीण जीवन सुगम हो सकेंगा और उसका विकास भी अवश्य हो सकेंगा। एक उद्यमी समाज के विकास में महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका निभाता है। आर्थिक विकास के लिए उद्यमशीलता और सतत् व्यापार में वृद्धि आवश्यक है। व्यापारिक और औद्योगिक क्षेत्र में तीव्रगति से परिवर्तन होने लगा है जिसके कारण उद्यमिता का महत्व भी बढ़ता जा रहा है और सरकार उद्यमिता को प्रोत्साहित कर रही है, जिससे अच्छी आर्थिक स्थिति प्राप्त करने के लिए रोजगार उपलब्ध कराकर गरीबी उन्मूलन किया जा सके। किसी भी देश के मानव संसाधन के विकास हेतु महिलाओं व पुरूषों की समान भागीदारी आवश्यक है। महिलाओं का जीवन सुरक्षित और भविष्य उज्जवल हो, उन्हें बराबरी का वर्जा और सम्मान मिले समाज और परिवार उनका आदर करें। वर्तमान समय में भारत में आर्थिक व सामाजिक क्षेत्र में हो रहे परिवर्तनों से आर्थिक विकास का क्षेत्र बढ़ता जा रहा है। उद्यमियों का उदय, समाज में व्याप्त आर्थिक, सामाजिक, धार्मिक, सांस्कृतिक और मनोवैज्ञानिक कारकों पर निर्भर करता है।







#### INTRODUCTION

The recent adoption of Integrated Fish Farming Systems in South East Asian nations, including India, is a result of the recent growth in human population, the poor economic conditions of farmers, and the rising demand for fish. The fish catch in Madhya Pradesh is primarily sold fresh and not exposed to other forms of processing, which significantly strengthens the state's domestic marketing infrastructure, which is, nonetheless, mainly insufficient.

#### BACKGROUND OF THE STUDY

The fish ponds were built to provide fish for the neighbourhood, battle poverty, ignorance, and disease through enhancing locals' health. But, lack of funding made it difficult to achieve these goals and objectives. Money in everyone's pockets is the project's central premise. Priority issues include youth unemployment and a lack of essential services in Madhya Pradesh, India's Bichhua Tehsil, district Chhindwara. It is a sustainability initiative that will give young people, women, and other interested locals the tools and resources they need to fight poverty, enhance their quality of life and health, and feed their families, communities, and themselves.

#### PROBLEM STATEMENT

In Bichhua Tehsil, rural unemployed women and youth are struggling with poverty and environmental deterioration. Many people struggle to feed their family enough to prevent starvation. The food gap is likely to result from this (time taken for rice to mature and harvest). Men always head to wetlands to look for fish when it rains during the rainy season, contributing to the problem of starvation. So, allocating a small amount of funding for this kind of project might be considered as a solution for the majority of family issues.

#### JUSTIFICATION

The availability of essential animal proteins as well as fish protein and other fish products are crucial components in the development of the brain. The only inexpensive source of animal protein that is free from calcification and cholesterol is fish. There is plenty of manual labour (unemployed youth) that will be used in excavation and masonry work to build additional fish ponds, and there are simple means of transport to the market. However, the lack of fish has reached an alarming level; when you visit the fish market, people are just lamenting when the refrigerated skeletal fish bones are on display.

#### MAIN OBJECTIVE

The overall goals are to protect the environment, show that fish farming is feasible, and support small-scale fish farmers with the long-term purpose of eradicating poverty and the scarcity of fresh fish. 



Bird distribution, habitat research (feeding, breeding, and roosting places), wildlife survey (diversity), rare and endangered species of fauna, and local characteristics of biodiversity in the study area are all included.

# Methodology for Faunal Study

- 1. For sampling, a 1 km linear transect will be selected for each location.
- 2. The following techniques will be used to sample the animals along each transect throughout the course of 1.5 hours.
  - a. The typical "Pollard Walk" approach will be used to sample butterflies, and all the species will be daily documented.
  - b. In addition to taking pictures of them, voucher specimens of the species that were not able to be recognised in the field will be collected.
  - c. Point sampling will be used to collect bird samples along the established transect (footpaths). With the use of field guides and images, all bird species will be recognised after being spotted through binoculars.
  - d. A "direct count on open width (20 m) transect" will be employed to sample mammals. Also, details on current records of animals by the by the villagers and locals will be also collected. In case of reptiles mainly lizards will be sampled by 'direct count on open width transects'.
